REFLECTION

"All of God's mighty men and women have been mighty in prayer. When Martin Luther was in the middle of his conflict with the Pope, the man of sin, he used to say that he could not get on without three hours a day in prayer. The greatest preacher of our times, Spurgeon, had pre-eminently the "gift of the knees;" the last prayer I ever heard him utter (at his own family worship) was one of the most wonderful that I ever listened to; it revealed the hiding of his power. Abraham Lincoln once said: "I have been driven many times to my knees by the overwhelming conviction that I had nowhere else to go; my own wisdom and that of all around me seemed insufficient for the day."

Pray for Lighthouse International Fellowship Church where we worship and minister. As an intentional international church, we encourage internationals to attend. We have the blessing of being multicultural, which is a taste of what heaven will be like. We also must translate every sermon into at least two languages. Pray that God would provide a stable and effective translation team. Pray too for God to send nationals with a hunger to be trained to serve in evangelism, discipling, and pastoral roles in the church, and for more Ukrainian churches and pastors to be open to serving the international community in their midst. Did you know that 1 in 7 Christians in the world do not live in their birth culture?
